

**McNeill's Rangers CSA
43rd McNeill's Rangers Invitational Skirmish**

McNeill's Rangers cordially invites you to join us July 10,11 &12, 2009 at Ft. Shenandoah, VA for our annual skirmish. Team matches this year are still unclassified. Individuals in Musket, Carbine and Revolver will be **classified**. Repeater and Smoothbore will be **unclassified**.

SCHEDULE:

FRIDAY:

- 0930:** Registration opens and individual matches commence.
 - All matches – Ten (10) shots for score.
 - All Musket, Carbine & Revolver matches, including aggregates are classified.
 - All Individual matches are awarded 3 places **except** Revolver in Expert, Sharpshooter & Marksman 1st and 2nd; Striker is awarded 1st, 2nd & 3rd places.
 - Repeater is unclassified, awarded 3 places for each 50 & 100 yd, and aggregate.
 - Smoothbore 25 & 50 yd and aggregate awarded 1st, 2nd & 3rd places.
 - UNLIMITED RE-ENTRIES.

1600: Air Rifle Individuals will begin at position # 55.

1700: Individual matches conclude for the day.

RANGE CLOSURES FOLLOWING CONCLUSION OF INDIVIDUAL MATCHES

SATURDAY:

- 0800:** Registration opens and Individual Matches begin.
- 1100:** Two relays of Air Rifle Individuals begin at position #55.
- 1230:** Revolver range closes.
- 1300:** Revolver Team Matches begin, Three (3) N-SSA members per team.
- 1430:** Individual matches conclude. Set up for Carbine Team Competition.
- 1500:** Carbine Team Matches begin, five (5) N-SSA members per team.

Note: Thirty (30) minutes after conclusion of Carbine Matches, Smoothbore & Mortar Matches begin. Smoothbore Matches will be held on Revolver Range.

Note: During Smoothbore & Mortar Matches, Air Rifle Team Matches will be held on position #55. All children ages through 14, should report to the Stat House by 1600.

SUNDAY:

- 0800:** Stat House opens for protests.
- 0900:** Musket Company Team Captains meeting at Stat House.
- 0915:** Opening Ceremonies to be immediately followed by Musket Company Matches, eight (8) N-S.S.A. members per team.

Note: Fifteen (15) minutes after the conclusion of the Musket Company Matches, Repeater Team Matches begin, three (3) members per team.

Note: All ranges close at the conclusion of Repeater Matches.

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TEAM EVENTS

CARBINE COMPANY EVENTS:

1. 100 yd – 7 6&6" tiles
2. 50yd – 20 clay pigeons on backer
3. 50yd – 5 6" paper plates on backer (2-minute rapid fire).
4. 50yd – 10 4x4" tiles.
5. 25yd – 4 hanging moskeets & 5 hanging triangles

REVOLVER COMPANY EVENTS: (3 members per team)

Each team must provide a safety officer & timer.

1. 25yd - 9 clay pigeons on backer.
2. 25yd - 6 4x4" tiles.
3. 25yd - 6 hanging clay pigeons.

MORTAR TEAM (4 members per team)

Teams to provide own aiming stake.

CHILDREN'S AIR RIFLE COMPANY EVENT

(3 members per team)

Each team must have their own timer (stop watch required).

All events 25 ft.

1. 9 – 60mm pigeons on backer.
2. 6 – 1 ½ " pots.
3. 6 – 2x2" tiles.

SMOOTHBORE COMPANY EVENTS (3 members per team)

1. 25yd – 9 clay pigeons on backer.
2. 25yd – 6 4x4" tiles.
3. 25yd – 6 4x4" wood blocks.

MUSKET COMPANY EVENTS (8 members per team)

1. 100yd – 10 6x6" tiles.
2. 50yd – 32 clay pigeons on backer.
3. 50yd – 8 6" paper plates on backer (2-minute rapid fire).
4. 50yd – 16 4x4" tiles.
5. 25yd – 6 hanging moskeets & 6 hanging triangles.

REPEATER COMPANY EVENTS (3 members per team)

1. 100yd – 10 6x6" tiles.
2. 50yd – 24 clay pigeons on backer.
3. 50yd – 12 4x4" tiles.

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Individuals Awards**

Musket, Carbine awards 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in 50yd, 100yd and Aggregate.
Revolver awards 25yd, 50yd and Aggregate are classified; 1st & 2nd place in class 1,2 & 3; 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in class 4.
Repeater awards 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in 50yd, 100yd & Aggregate.
Smoothbore awards 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in 25yd, 50yd and Aggregate.

1. Musket-Carbine Aggregate 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
2. 50 Yard Aggregate: (Musket, Carbine & Revolver) 1st, 2nd & 3rd place.
3. Grand Aggregate: 1st, 2nd and 3rd (No charge). Note: Does not include Repeater or Smoothbore scores.

TEAM AWARDS: Three children per team: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

For competitors without Air Rifles, some will be available. Notify host team prior to skirmish: **1100 Saturday is the deadline.**

Air Rifle Team Competition will be conducted at the far end of the main range during the Mortar Competition at positions 55-67.

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McNEILL'S RANGERS AIR RIFLE COMPETITION RULES

In addition to the N-S.S.A. Rules on "youth competition", section 38

1. NO RIFLES ARE TO BE SHOT AT ANY OTHER TIME EXCEPT WHILE ON THE RANGE AT THE TIME OF THE COMPETITION.

2. Air rifles are not to be handled by the children while on Ft. Shenandoah Property except at the individual or team events.
3. No air rifles are to be loaded behind the line.
4. Each competitor must be accompanied by an adult, going to and coming from the range, and while at the range.
5. When carried to and from the range, rifles are to be in a box, sleeve or a rifle case.
- 6. EACH MEMBER THAT HAS SPONSORED A CHILD OR CHILDREN WILL ACCEPT FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ACTIONS OF EACH CHILD.**
7. Use of automatic or semi-automatic guns is prohibited.

INDIVIDUAL TARTGET COMPETITION

1. Targets are National Target Co. TQ-14 50ft silhouette, TQ-40 5 meter, TQ-5/1 25ft. All targets will be shot at a distance of 25 ft.
2. Each relay will be 20-minutes long.
3. All targets are 10 shots for score.
4. Distance from firing line to targets is 25 feet.
5. Competitors may be assisted on the firing line.
6. Air rifles must be pointed down range at all times.
7. All competitors must be cleared by a safety officer before leaving the firing line.
8. Bring stop watches.
9. Bring scopes or binoculars.
10. All competitors and adults MUST wear safety glasses.

TEAM COMPETITION

1. All events will be three minutes except for the stake.
2. The stake event will be five minutes.
3. A penalty time will be added to the finish time for each un-hit target.
4. Distance from the firing line to the targets will be 25 feet.
5. No more than three individuals per team, per event.
6. Competitors may be assisted on the firing line while loading.
